Description:

The projects range in scope from refurbishments and extensions at existing hospices, to complete new builds. These include:

- **Walsall** - Redevelopment and refurbishment of existing unit £1.25m and new dining room £50k
- **Selly Oak** - Refurbishment, new hydrotherapy pool and physiotherapy facilities £300k
- **Worcester** - New Hospice £3.5m.

The new hospice in Walsall was built on an existing site which had been abandoned before completion and the partial building had been fire damaged. The construction shell was repaired and then adapted to create a two storey hospice.

All of the projects require specialist facilities designed to offer the highest standards of care to terminally ill children, including hydrotherapy pools, jacuzzi/spa and multi sensory rooms.

Wakemans maintain tight budgetary control when working for the Trust to obtain best value for money and in so doing conserve the charities vital funds.
