The £3.6m project was officially opened by HRH the Princess Royal in September 2007, and provides a centre for the provision of services to the deaf, including training, support, welfare and leisure activities for the deaf community, both locally and on a national basis.

The innovative scheme was designed by D5 Architects of Birmingham and the Main Contractor was Mansell plc.
